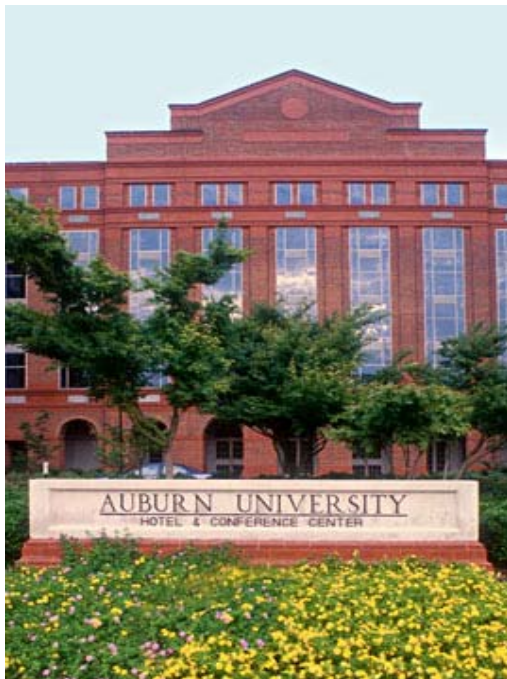

Attendees are invited to participate in a very important “Town Hall” meeting Wednesday afternoon, February 15, to discuss AABI strategies for responding to pending FAA rulemaking and other issues related to flight education and pilot hiring. John Allen, FAA AFS 2, will be a special guest.

The Industry/Educator Forum will be held Thursday morning, February 16. This past summer’s Industry/Educator Forum was transformed into a joint project of AABI, FAA and UAA, with the theme of *Applying Education Collaboratively: Raising the Bar on Aviation Safety*. It was a review of aviation education potential to instill decision-making skills, monitoring flight operations, applying ASAP & FOQA programs, and improving General



Aviation (GA) safety; and included unprecedented participation by high-ranking FAA representatives. The Educator Responder Panels presented a “snapshot” during the UAA Fall Education Conference in Indianapolis, Ind., and will fully report out during the AABI Winter Meeting. Plan now to attend!



Following the Members Luncheon Thursday afternoon, a Visiting Team Training Workshop, focusing on Policies & Procedures and Team Protocols. This training is a refresher

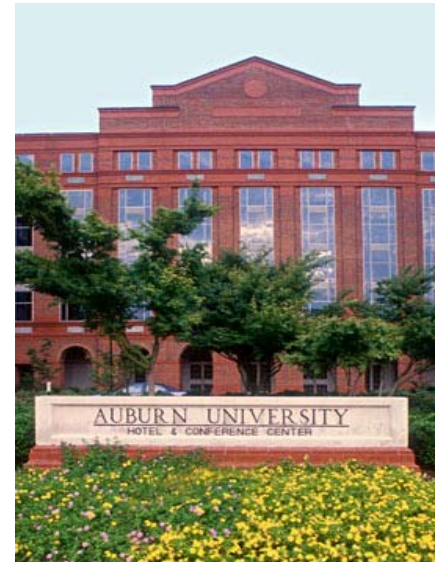
