Criterion 2.2.4 (2-year programs), Criterion 3.2.4 (4-year programs) or Criterion 4.2.4 (graduate programs) - Public Information.

Each AABI-accredited aviation program MUST provide reliable information to the public on student success in the program, **at least annually**. The following Student Achievement Data MUST appear in easily accessible locations including public program websites:

- a. The Program Educational Goals of each accredited program, as publicly published, and how these Program Educational Goals are assessed by the program.
- b. Student retention and graduation rates, including the number of degrees produced each year, the percentage of students enrolled one year after starting the program, and the percentage of bachelor's students graduating within 6 years.
- c. The employment rate and types of employment (aviation, aviation-related or other positions) of fulltime graduates within 1 year of graduation.
- d. Other student achievement data, as determined by the program.

The report of Student Achievement Data MUST include the revision date. To ensure accuracy and accessibility, each institution with AABI accredited programs must provide an Annual Report of Compliance with AABI Criterion 2.2.4 to AABI by December 1 each year (for the preceding academic year). The report MUST include:

- 1. A URL for each accredited program's webpage and the link within that page that leads to student achievement data; and
- 2. A PDF containing student achievement data (Student Achievement Template as found on the AABI website).
