

Aviation Accreditation Board International February 23, 2024

SUMMARY OF RECENT ACTION

The Aviation Accreditation Board International (AABI) is required to inform the public about its accreditation decisions. One of the ways AABI does this is to provide the public with information about the accreditation decision process, the nature and scope of AABI accreditation activity and the importance and value of accreditation. AABI also provides the public with detailed descriptions of its accreditation policies and procedures by publishing its Accreditation Criteria Manual (Form 201) and Policies & Procedures Manual (Form 225), along with all the AABI forms, on its website: http://www.aabi.aero/forms.html (Standard 2.A., October 4, 2021, *CHEA Standards and Procedures for Recognition*).

Interim Report: Hampton University

The Board action was to accept the institution's response to Recommendation 10 with no further reports required for *that* Recommendation.

The Board action was also to require an interim report, due January 6, 2025, to provide an update on the process of obtaining FAR 141 certification. In addition, provide updated information on who is teaching the ground courses in the program.
