

Aviation Accreditation Board International February 23, 2024

SUMMARY OF RECENT ACTION

The Aviation Accreditation Board International (AABI) is required to inform the public about its accreditation decisions. One of the ways AABI does this is to provide the public with information about the accreditation decision process, the nature and scope of AABI accreditation activity and the importance and value of accreditation. AABI also provides the public with detailed descriptions of its accreditation policies and procedures by publishing its Accreditation Criteria Manual (Form 201) and Policies & Procedures Manual (Form 225), along with all the AABI forms, on its website: http://www.aabi.aero/forms.html (Standard 2.A., October 4, 2021, CHEA Standards and Procedures for Recognition).

Reaffirmation:

Louisiana Tech University

The Board action was to reaffirm accreditation of the following programs for a period of five years:

- B.S. Aviation Management (AABI Aviation Management)
- B.S. Professional Aviation (AABI Flight Education)

The Board accepted the institution's responses to Recommendations 1 and 3. An interim report is required, due by January 6, 2025, which provides the evidence specified below for Recommendations 2 and 4.

Recommendation 2: Faculty MUST engage in teaching, service, and scholarship (Criterion 3.5.4).

Provide evidence of scholarship. The evidence should include titles and journals for published scholarly work, grants submitted, and other areas of scholarly endeavor.

Recommendation 4: Institutional structure, support, financial re sources, and constructive leadership MUST be adequate to assure the quality and continuity of the aviation program throughout the period of accreditation (Criterion 3.7).

Provide evidence of progress toward adequate institutional structure, support, financial resources, and constructive leadership to assure the quality and continuity of the aviation program throughout the period of accreditation.
